LOT 630

A gold backed and platinum fronted diamond brooch, circa 1910, in an Art Nouveau scroll pierced and foliate openwork design, mounted with cushion cut and eight cut diamonds, weight 9.6g, width 4cm.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

630. Central principal diamond is a fairly clear stone. Approx 4mm diameter.

The other diamonds have one or two internal inclusions. Three or four do have chips.

Larger diamond to the central drop has a surface reaching fracture running partially across the table facet.

Some tarnish/discolouration to the back setting of the two drops.

Brooch fitting at back is removable and is slightly loose, but in good working order.

Generally the piece is in fairly good condition and an attractive piece.

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
