Lea Cum Privilegio Regis' (Map of the County), 17th century engraving with later colour in outline on laid paper, 42.5cm x 51cm, within an ebonized and gilt frame.

Condition Report

30. Cropped within plate line and with some small tears without loss to edges. Appears to be laid onto mount board around the edges of the paper, but does not appear to be stuck in the central area. Some light creasing heaviest to the bottom corners. Small brown stain (like ink) below on armorial. Mount and backing does not appear to be archival. Frame with some scuffs and scratches. Unexamined out of frame.
