A Chinese Transitional blue and white porcelain jar, mid-17th century, the barrel form body painted with two birds flying above and perched in bamboo beside butterflies flying about peonies, rocks and vapours, unmarked, height 27.5cm (drilled hole and star crack to base), together with a carved hardwood stand.

## Condition Report

1090. Generally good condition except for the drilled hole and star cracks to the base. Otherwise the body of the jar is in good order with no chips, other cracks or restoration. Typical surface scratches and wear to glaze. Nicely painted. Wood stand has a drilled hole through middle and is split.
