A Chinese Imari porcelain ginger jar, 18th century, the ovoid body painted and gilt with a pair of phoenixes flying amidst peonies, underglaze blue double ring to base, height 21.4cm.

## **Condition Report**

1180. Generally good condition. No significant damage or repairs. Typical wear to enamels and gilt particularly to one area of iron red decoration. It looks like it may have been a lamp base at some stage as there is glue residue around the outside of the rim/neck which would require cleaning/removal, but it obviously was not drilled.
