A collection of Chinese ceramics and works of art, 18th century and mostly later, including a blue and white Batavian ware saucer, Qianlong period, painted with a rabbit within floral band, diameter 11.6cm, a provincial blue and white bowl, diameter 14.2cm (hairline cracks), a bronze Buddha and a metal pagoda, height 58.5cm (some faults).

Condition Report

1029. Blue and white Batavian saucer - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical minor surface scratches and wear.

Blue and white ginger jar - good condition.

Famille verte ginger jar - good condition.

Continental 'export' style bowl - good condition.

Blue and white provincial bowl - hairline crack to rim.

Blue and white export bowl - crack across middle of bowl and chipped.

Small blue and white export bowl - good condition.

Iron tetsubin - good condition, typical wear.

Chinese tea tile/brick - generally good order, but typical nibbles/chips to edges.

Blue and red jar and cover - good condition.

Modern famille rose vase - good condition.

Small famille verte jar - good condition.

Small teapot - missing lid and crack to spout.
