### Condition Report

1067. Three with purple mounts are in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. All have small horizontal creases near lower edge and slight staining/discolouration.

Two with gilt mounts - one badly stained and discoloured and with two horizontal tears. Other with significant tears/splits.

Corporal punishment scene has some staining/discolouration, otherwise ok.
