### LOT 1246

A collection of Chinese Yixing stoneware, mostly 20th century, comprising twelve various teapots, three cups and a box and cover (minor faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

### Condition Report

1246. Smallest brown teapot - two chips to rim and small chip to spout.

Small plain squat brown teapot - small chip to underside of cover rim.

Swan teapot - small hairline where handle meets body and small chip to underside of cover rim.

Teapot with Buddhistic lion finial - small firing crack to handle joint and few minor chips.

Smaller teapot with Buddhistic lion finial - small chip to tip of spout.

Hexagonal teapot - looks Continental, not Chinese, damaged cover.

Circular box and cover - looks Japanese, cover with chip to rim, lower part with numerous chips/losses to rim.

Square teapot - one of ring supports to side is detached, but present. Otherwise ok.

One teacup is cracked.

All other pieces in apparently good condition with no significant damage or repairs.
