A rare Chinese famille rose enamelled export porcelain jar and cover, 18th century, probably Yongzheng period, the baluster body painted with a scene of a boy lighting a firecracker as a group of twelve other boys and four maidens watch on, one boy putting his hands to his ears, divided by a banana plant emanating from rocks below rising vapours, the shoulder with ruyi head and trellis bands, the domed cover painted with three further boys and banana plant in a fenced garden, underglaze blue double ring to base, total height 42.5cm (restoration to rim of cover).

Condition Report

1300. Jar is in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels. The cover has a repaired/restored section of rim (approx 13.5cm long). It also has two small chips to the underside rim, as well as typical surface scratches and wear.
