A Japanese Imari 'Black Ship' porcelain punch bowl, Meiji period, of steep sided circular form, the interior painted and gilt with ruyi shaped panels filled with alternating black ships and Buddhist lions, reserved against phoenix and dragon filled iron red ground, the exterior with phoenix and foliate roundels within a band of scrolling leafy tendrils, unmarked, height 16.3cm, diameter 38.1cm, together with a carved wood stand.

1155. Good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Tiny glaze scuff/chip to rim. Typical light surface scratches and wear to gilt, slightly more pronounced wear to tilt gilt on rim and centre of bowl. Wood stand in generally good order.
