A Chinese underglaze blue and red crackle glazed porcelain vase, late Qing dynasty, of ogee baluster form, painted with five sages within iron oxide borders, height 23.5cm, together with two Chinese blue and white crackle glazed dishes, diameters 27cm and 28.5cm (both cracked).

### Condition Report

1223. Vase in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Slight staining to glaze.

Blue and white figural dish - 7cm crack to rim and slight glaze discolouration, otherwise ok. Typical wear and scratches.

Crackled dish - unsightly firing crack to rim, otherwise typical wear and scratches. No restoration or other chips and cracks.
