A collection of Japanese pottery, Meiji period and later, including an Imari jar and cover with Buddhistic lion finial, height 13.5cm, an earthenware figure of a recumbent dog of Fo, length 27cm, and a pair of Imari jars and domed covers, height 17cm.

Condition Report

1304. Kutani koro - missing one handle, other repaired.

Blue and white gourd vase - the top flared neck section of the vase has been restored. There are some scratches to the overpainting. The lower two bulbs are in good order with typical light scratches and wear.

Satsuma vase - wear to gilt and enamels all-over.

Japanese blue and white vase - good condition.

Globular blue and white jar and cover - cover is chipped.

Ovoid blue and white jar and cover - good condition

Blue and white hexagonal pot - minor chips.

Blue and white gourd vase - good condition.

Imari tripod koro - both handles repaired, otherwise ok.

Pair of Imari jars and covers - both in generally good order. Typical wear.

Imari sugar box and cover - good condition, wear to gilt.

Imari bottle vase - good condition, but wear to gilt.

Kutani sugar box and cover - good condition, some wear to gilt.

2 Satsuma cups - both cracked and crazed.
