A Chinese pale celadon jade pendant, probably late Qing dynasty, carved and pierced with a dragon, length 5.2cm, together with a silver mounted celadon jade pendant, length 3.5cm, and a Chinese rose quartz pendant of gourd form, length 5.8cm (minor chip to edge).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1011. Dragon pendant - generally good condition, minor chips and scuffs to edges. No significant damage or repairs.

Silver mounted jade pendant - good condition, few minor chips to edges.

Rose quartz pendant - minor chip to edge otherwise ok. All with typical surface scratches and wear.

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
