A collection of Chinese hardstone and jade carvings, mostly 20th century and later, including an archaistic bird, length 6.5cm, and a celadon jade archer's ring, length 4cm.

Condition Report

1302. Liu Hai & toad - broken at ankles and re-glued

Green hardstone vase and cover - minor chips

Two soapstone figural seals - minor chips

Small agate bottle - chips to rim

Peach form snuff bottle - crack to rim and hole in side and wear

Green figure of lady - chips and losses to figure

Moulded green snuff bottle - chip to rim and footrim and to some of relief, also wear to surface

Soapstone monkey - chipped to foot

Jade figure - poor quality carving and chipped to edges and base

Small red stone snuff bottle - minor chips, internal hairline inclusions

Large red bottle - minor chips and wear

All other items in generally good condition with, if anything, very minor chips, scuffs or nicks but no significant damage or repair.
