Condition Report

1309. In generally good decorative condition with typical wear to inside and out. There is one significant area of repair to the side with some repainting and filler. This can be seen in the third photograph on our website, showing the exterior with the repaired area being in the right hand corner of the red ground panel. There are also some smaller areas of repair and some hairline cracks to exterior. As can be seen in the images on our website of the turquoise interior and base, there are some losses to enamel, hairline stress cracks and obvious areas of repairs.
