A pair of Chinese blue and white porcelain vases, Kangxi period, each baluster body painted with Buddhist symbol pendants, beneath a ruyi head band to neck, underglaze blue double ring to base, height 18cm (both with chips to edge of bases and one with small hairline to rim).

## Condition Report

1280. Vase 1 - 3cm hairline crack to rim and four chips to edge of foot, otherwise typical surface scratches and wear to glaze, few minor glaze blemishes, but no significant cracks or repairs. Good vibrant painting. Vase 2 - generally good condition with no cracks or repairs. Few chips and hairline bruise to edge of foot as well as typical glaze fritting. Otherwise the body is in good order with only typical surface scratches and wear to glaze and a few typical minor glaze blemishes. Good vibrant painting. Neither vase has a cover.
