A pair of Japanese cloisonné vases, Meiji period, each shouldered tapering body decorated with blossoming branches and flowers on a pale blue ground, height 18.2cm (minor hairlines), together with another Japanese cloisonné vase, Meiji period, of lobed tapering form, decorated with polychrome flowerheads on a black ground, height 18.4cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1052. Blue vase 1 - small 2cm long hairline to rim. Otherwise generally good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear. No chips or repairs.

Blue vase 2 - there are a series of nine stress hairlines to lower half of the vase, some of them connected. No significant damage. No chips or repairs.

Otherwise ok.

Flowerhead black ground vase - generally good condition, some minor misfiring to the enamel around the foot, possibly even a small repair. Otherwise the vase is in good condition with no significant damage or repair.
