A Chinese Canton Export ivory chess set, mid to late 19th century, one side stained red, the other side natural representing the Chinese versus the Mongols, height of king 10.4cm (some minor faults), together with an export ivory paperknife, the handle carved and pierced with a standing figure amidst a cage work of scrolling foliage, length 25.5cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1215. Red stained set - generally good condition with no significant damage, but some small chips and nicks. Typical wear to staining and as can be seen from the images on our website, some of the weapons are either missing or damaged.

Natural set - similar condition to red set, with some nicks and chips and some missing weapon or damaged weapons.

Ivory knife in generally good order with typical wear and a few very minor nicks to carving.
