A Victorian gold and citrine brooch, the top mounted with three oval cut citrines within a scroll pierced surround with engraved decoration, the front with an oval citrine set single stone drop, unmarked, weight 12.9g, width 5.2cm, length 7.3cm, with a case.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

503. The drop is possibly associated with the top. One bead missing from the top of the left hand side. There is a crack and an old repair to the lower right hand side of the top part. There are several old repairs/restoration/strengthening when viewed from the back. Hinge pin slightly bent. Loop to top of drop is not properly centred when viewed from the back. Although not tested by us, suggested grade of gold would be 9ct. The piece would benefit from careful professional cleaning.

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
