A gold, half-pearl, ruby and peridot fringe necklace, late 19th/early 20th century, the front with a row of twenty-one tassel drops, unmarked, weight 13g, length 39cm (one ruby missing), with a Harvey & Gore leather case.

Estimate: £500 - £800

Condition Report

505. The half-pearls are of attractive fresh colour. The rubies are being offered as natural and are of medium to dark colour saturation. Largest diameter approx. 3mm, smallest diameter approx. 2mm. The peridots are of medium to pale colour saturation. Some of the graduated drops are distorted to the knife edge bars. One half-pearl missing near to one end. Some of the claws to the gems are rather worn with resulting distortion in some cases. Small dent to the clasp. We would suggest the carat of gold could be 15ct, but we have not tested it ourselves.

The case - is a little grubby within. The case hinges are both very loose. Stain to lid of case. Edges of case are rather scuffed. Both the hook and eye fittings are present. The case is slightly warped.

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
