An early 20th century Russian diamond, sapphire and blister pearl brooch, 56 zolotnik, designed as a stag beetle, the abdomen set with a blister pearl, otherwise set with variously cut diamonds and sapphires, indistinct maker's mark to pin, weight 15.5g, length 6.3cm.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

545. The diamonds slightly draw colour and have one or two internal inclusions. The principal diamond at the front of the brooch is currently mounted upside down. The sapphires are of medium colour saturation. The pearl has some dirt around the edge but otherwise in good condition.

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
