An 18ct gold, ruby and diamond oval cluster ring, claw set with the oval cut ruby within a surround of circular cut diamonds between scrolled shoulders, London 1981, weight 3.4g, ring size approx M1/2, with a case.

Condition Report

573. The ruby is offered as natural. It has a surface reaching inclusion near to one of the claws which does appear as a small scratch to the stone and in certain lights can be seen without magnification. Further inclusions visible with a 10x loop. Ruby has three chips to girdle/underside of girdle. Approx. size of ruby 7mm x 5.5mm, estimated depth 0.25mm.

The surrounding diamonds generally have a few piqué and gletz inclusions. The diamonds are approx. 0.04ct each.

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
