An early 19th century mourning brooch, the central glazed hair locket compartment with the figure of a woman in mourning, standing beside a column, and detailed 'Never To Be Forgot' within a border of half-pearls, length 3.3cm.

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## Condition Report

667. It is slightly grubby inside the locket. The pictorial panel has old restoration around 4 o'clock. The pearls are in good condition. The hinged pin and hook are later base metal fittings. The piece is probably gold set.

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
