## LOT 705

A gold ring, mounted with three cushion cut rubies alternating with two pairs of cushion cut diamonds between cushion cut diamond set single stone sides, the mount decorated with scroll pierced sides, detailed '18', weight 4.3g, ring size approx L.

## Condition Report

705. One of the diamonds in one of the pairs of diamonds is slightly raised in its setting and slightly overlaps the diamond next to it. This diamond is out of alignment. One diamond on the other pair of diamonds has a surface reaching inclusion to the table facet edge and down that side. The diamonds at either end are in better condition. The rubies are being offered as natural, one or two have tiny nicks to the surface, but are otherwise in generally good condition. The shank is also detailed  D&L . The shank is a bit thin and distorted at the back. The claw tips are showing signs of wear. Approx. size of principal ruby  5mm x 4mm. Total diamond weight approx. 0.40ct. Suggested age  Edwardian period circa 1910
