Condition Report

711. In overall good condition. The turquoise are well matched and are of medium blue colour. The diamonds seem to be attractive white stones, with one or two tiny inclusions. The pearls are in good condition, with an attractive lustre. It is likely to be gold backed and silver set but it is quite tarnished and unmarked. Diameter of flowerhead approx. 1.2cm.
