A gold, demantoid garnet and seed pearl brooch, circa 1910, designed as a spider's web within a foliate wreath shaped surround, unmarked, weight 2.1g, diameter 2.6cm, with a Liberty & Co London circular textile box.

### Condition Report

719. The pin of the hinge is slightly pushing out at one end. The hook is slightly bent over. The two pearls are in good condition. The demantoid has very slight wear to the table facet edges but has no significant bad chips. There is a small loop by the ties of the wreath to take a safety chain. The Liberty case slightly grubby but no major damage to the textile material. The diameter of the case is 4.3cm.
