### LOT 536

An 18ct gold and diamond five stone ring, mounted with a row of cushion cut diamonds, Birmingham 1908, weight 2.8g, ring size approx M, and an 18ct gold, ruby and diamond seven stone cluster ring, claw set with the circular cut ruby within a surround of six circular cut diamonds, detailed '18K 750', weight 2.3g, ring size approx N.

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### Condition Report

536. Five stone diamond ring - diamonds have slight variation of colour, but are largely bright whit stones. Under magnification they are fairly included stones. Slight thinning to back of shank. Otherwise ring generally in good condition.

Ruby and diamond ring - ruby has a couple of nibbles to facet edges and a faint scratch to one side of table. It is a fairly included stone, but with medium colour saturation. Surrounding diamonds have a slight grey tint, but are quite bright and sparkling, under magnification they have a few inclusions. Shank is ever so slightly distorted at the back with some thinning. Ring would benefit from a clean.

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
