### LOT 556

A pair of Victorian pendant earrings with thistle motifs, with later wire fittings, length 2.2cm, with a case, a banded agate heart shaped pendant, fitted to a split ring, a silver mounted Blue John circular pendant with a silver neckchain, weight 6.7g, a silver filigree leaf brooch, weight 3.4g, a cabochon amethyst bar brooch, a silver and garnet half-hoop ring, weight 1.8g, a gold, silver, green and colourless paste ring, weight 2.6g, and a small Victorian slide action pencil.

### Condition Report

556. Victorian earrings - one has old test mark to front, both with a couple of small dents, both with later fittings.

Heart agate - tiny nick to point of heart.

Blue John - some light surface scratching with a noticeable internal crack which shows iridescence at certain angles.

Silver filigree leaf - stem of leaf slightly bent.

Garnet ring - few nibbles to facet edges of stone, minor thinning to shank.

Paste ring - misshaped head of ring and distorted shank. Pastes with heavy wear to facet edges in places.

Two colourless pastes badly damaged, one with only the pavilion remaining.

Pencil - gem set terminal chipped.

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
