A George III silver étui of tapered oval form with hinged lid, decorated in relief with scrolls and scallops, weight 40.6g, fitted with a glass bottle, length 7cm.

## Condition Report

371. The étui appears to be completely unmarked. The domed section of the hinge lid has a repair around the reeded band and has lost definition and there is also a small tear hole to one corner. Hinge is good and lid closes tightly. Repoussé work to body is good with nice detail. Small dent near to base and small lead repair to base.

The glass bottle may well be matched as it is not a good fit. Glass has small nibbles/nicks. Silver cover is split.
