An early George III silver Warwick cruet, the stand with central scroll handle above five gadrooned apertures, raised on scroll legs terminating in scallop shell feet, fitted with three graduated casters with spiral reeded decoration and pierced covers and two cut glass bottles with silver scroll handles, collars and hinged lids, London 1769 by Jabez Daniell & James Mince, weight 975.5g excluding two bottles, height of stand 24.5cm.

Condition Report

315. Overall in good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Only typical light surface wear and scratches to silver, but relief decoration still good and crisp. All pieces with matching hallmarks or part marks. Original glass bottles in good order with typical wear and some very minor scuffs/nicks, but no significant damage. One interior is very cloudy, the other is better. Good clear hallmarks. All pieces with matching engraved crests.
