LOT 637

A gold, seed pearl and enamelled brooch, designed as a naval crown, detailed '14ct', fitted with a safety chain, weight 4.6g, width 2.6cm, with a case, another enamelled brooch designed as a naval crown and a further enamelled brooch, designed as the flag of the Royal Yacht Squadron, detailed '800'.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

637. Naval crown brooch 14ct - amateur repair to central shield with residual glue evident, a couple of chips to the half shields on either side, bar at the back of the brooch is slightly loose.

Second naval crown brooch - tiny nicks to edge of white enamel and to the red/green enamel, both really only noticeable under magnification. The bar fitting is working well.

Flag brooch - there is the odd old nick to the edge of the red enamel and a few surface chips to the top left corner edge of the enamel. The bar to the back is bent but following the bend of the flag, so I think this is intentional and it clips nicely into place under the hook. The hook has potentially been replaced or reattached in the past.

The three brooches overall have some light surface wear/scratching, which is largely only noticeable under magnification.
