An Edwardian Heal & Sons oak 'Owl' cabinet, designed by Sir Ambrose Heal in 1905-1906, fitted with a pair of cupboard doors with applied circular panels centred by rotating latch handles, the drawers with recessed 'squashed heart' handles, height 152cm, width 112cm, depth 53cm. Note: a similar cabinet can be seen in 'Sir Ambrose Heal and the Heal Cabinet Factory 1897-1939' by Oliver S. Heal, page 179cm.

Condition Report

2410. General overall appearance and condition is good, with some slight fading to the front, a small black surface line on the top edge of one drawer and some minor scuffs, surface indentations and marks commensurate with its age. The plinth base is slightly loosely attached on one side. The top panel has a series of screws around the outer edges of the sides and rear and some slight gapping to the timbers. Small split to one handle.
