Condition Report

2573. The winding handle is present and operates the mechanism, and the turn table is working, but please be aware we give no guarantees to the working order of any Lot. There is a thin crack to the edge of the top and the metal collar around the winding hole is missing. The metal arm support has a worn surface and some light surface rust. There is no sound box and some fairly typical dents to the brass horn. The horn does appear to be original.
