A late 19th century woolwork panel, worked in coloured wools with a British twin-masted ship, 36cm x 46cm, later mounted within a Victorian bird's eye maple frame, together with another similar marine woolwork of a ship, indistinctly named and dated, 36cm x 40cm, framed.

Condition Report

2805. The larger woolwork is in good order with only some minor damage to the frame. The smaller sampler is quite faded and discoloured in places. It has also lost some of its wool in places, particularly around the edges.

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
