A Rolex Oyster Perpetual Day-Date 18ct gold cased gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, circa 1990, Ref. No. 18238, the signed and jewelled movement numbered '559906', the signed gilt dial with baton hour markers, day aperture at 12 o'clock and date aperture at 3 o'clock and detailed 'Rolex Oyster Perpetual Day-Date Superlative Chronometer Officially Certified' within a circular cut diamond set surround, Rolex crown to winding button, on a Rolex tapering link president bracelet with foldover clasp, detailed '55B', '8385' and '750 18K', case diameter 3.5cm, total weight 143.6g.

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## Condition Report

1050. Watch is in generally good condition. It is in good working order, adjusts smoothly with all features working, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The crown screws down tightly.

Typical light surface scratches to case and bracelet, but nothing significant. Few typical tiny nicks to edge of glass visible under magnification, but again of no real significance. Clasp in good working order. Diamonds around bezel are bright, white and sparkly.

The watch was entered by a local private gentleman. He has had it for approximately 15 years, having purchased it at auction. We believe, but are not certain, it had one other previous owner. Unfortunately, no box, paperwork of service history.

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
