A 19th century keywind open-faced pocket alarm watch with Continental fusee movement sounding on a bell, the enamelled dial with black Arabic numerals, the case back interior numbered '15239', case diameter 5.5cm, with a base metal travelling case and key.

Condition Report

1034. Has typical wear and surface scratches and a few minor dents to back. Both hinges are good, and front and back close tightly.

The dial has numerous scratches mostly around the centre, but does not appear to be cracked or chipped.

Both the movement and alarm mechanism wind smoothly, the watch starts ticking but only for a few seconds, then only starts again with a gentle shake. The alarm mechanism appears to be in good order and sounds as it should.
