A late 19th century French brass one-piece cased carriage alarm clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the enamel dial with Roman hour numerals and subsidiary alarm dial and indistinctly inscribed 'Henry Capt...', the glazed case with swing handle and bracket feet, height 14.4cm.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1163. The clock is in generally good but a little dirty condition. It would certainly benefit from a clean. The movement winds and adjusts smoothly but it does not run, no response from balance wheel. The alarm mechanism winds smoothly, activates and sounds at correct time.

Dial generally ok but lettering is worn/faded and a scratch below 4 o'clock.

All glass panels appear to be in good condition.

Case is a bit dirty with typical light surface scratches and wear but no significant damage. Handle screws look like replacements. Hinge door is good.
