A Victorian burr walnut bracket clock with eight day twin fusee movement striking hours and half hours on a gong, the backplate detailed 'Dent 61, Strand & 4, Royal Exchange London 47031', the similarly signed silvered circular dial with black Roman hour numerals, the case with stepped top and moulded pediment above pierced fret panels, on a cushion and plinth base with bracket feet, height 34.5cm, with pendulum.

## Condition Report

1230. The clock is in generally good condition. Case has typical scuffs and nicks. Also a couple of splits to wood on the front just below to hinge and next to the locking plate (see our web images). Dial in good order. Chain fusee movement winds smoothly and runs. Striking mechanism also in good order but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
