## LOT 1175

A late 19th century French ormolu cased mantel clock, the eight day movement with silk suspension, striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the embossed brass dial inset with white enamel hour plaques with blue Roman hour numerals, the rococo scroll moulded balloon shaped case cast with flowers and foliate scrolls, on an integral scroll moulded base, length 26.5cm, with pendulum and key.

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## Condition Report

1175. The clock is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. The case is dirty and would benefit from a clean. Typical surface scratches and wear. Both convex glass doors in good order. The movement winds smoothly and runs but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The striking mechanism also appears to be in good order.

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
