A late 19th century French ormolu cased mantel clock, the circular enamel dial with black Arabic numerals and flower festoons, the case with urn surmount and acanthus swags above ribbon bows, acanthus swags and foliate scrolls, on an inverted breakfront base and foliate toupie feet, height 56cm, with fitted quartz movement and detached eight day movement, with pendulum and winding key.

Estimate: £700 - £1,000

Condition Report

1215. The case is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Ormolu a little dusty and dirty, so would benefit from a clean. Dial is good with only minor chip to edge of top hole. As can be seen in our website images, it has a quartz movement. The other movement is detached, we presume it does not work and that was the reason it was removed.

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
