### LOT 1180

An early 19th century mahogany circular wall timepiece with brass four pillar chain driven single fusee movement, the repainted wooden circular dial with Roman hour numerals, cast brass bezel and glass within a moulded surround, the case box with hinged doors to sides and underside, diameter 36.5cm, with pendulum (faults).

### Condition Report

1180. The movement winds smoothly and runs, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Overall the timepiece is in dirty condition. Dial obviously in poor condition. Bezel and glass are good. Hinge is good. The mahogany surround in good order with typical nicks to edges, but no significant damage. Box is ok, but needs a bit of work. Trap door is good. Two side doors are a bit loose and wobbly and some door edge mouldings are missing. Small split to bottom left corner of box.
