An early 20th century French brass cased diminutive carriage clock by Richard & Cie, with eight day movement striking hours and half hours on a gong, the backplate with stamped maker's mark, the enamel rectangular dial with Roman hour numerals and inscribed 'Howell & James Co to the Queen London', the corniche case with bevelled glass panels and swing handle, height 12.3cm, with winding key.
