## LOT 1160

A late 19th century French engraved brass one-piece cased carriage alarm clock with eight day movement striking hours and half hours and repeating on a bell, the backplate stamped with 'B' in a circle maker's mark, possibly Jules Brunelot, the white enamel dial with black Roman hour numerals and subsidiary alarm dial, the foliate engraved case with bevelled glass panels, swing handle and bracket feet, height 17.5cm, with winding key.

Estimate: £700 - £1,000

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## Condition Report

1160. The clock is in generally good condition. Case with only typical light surface scratches and wear. No significant damage or repairs, all glass panels in good order. Engraving nice and crisp. Dial in good order, but some wear to indistinct lettering and alarm Arabic numerals. The striking mechanism works as it should. The balance wheel is free, but does not run.

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
