An 18ct gold and diamond ring, designed as a coiled snake, the head mounted with the principal rose cut diamond with rose cut diamond set eyes, London 1933, weight 5.4g, ring size approx M1/2.

Condition Report

501. The principal rose diamond looks to be a fairly clear stone with one or two tiny nicks to the facet edges. The ring has been sized upwards in the past with an addition of gold at the back resulting in redefinition of the coiling of the back of the snake. Hallmark otherwise clear. Maker's mark \diamond JF \diamond . Diamond is approx 0.1ct.

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
