### LOT 550

A ruby and diamond bracelet, designed as a row of five graduated collet set oval cut rubies alternating with six graduated diamond set four stone divisions at intervals, otherwise with expanding bar links, on a snap clasp, length 17cm, unmarked.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

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### Condition Report

550. Some wear to the sides of the links of the bracelet, the rubies are medium to light colour saturation with some wear to the facet edges. Suggested age 1920-40. Tongue of clasp looks to be replaced, box of clasp is engraved 180, the diamonds are variously cut old cut stones that look to be fairly clear but are of differing proportions. Some wear to the joining of the links, the rubies are offered as natural.

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
