A Victorian varicoloured enamelled brooch, designed as a row of garden birds, including a magpie, a blue tit and a bullfinch, width 4.8cm, and a colourless paste set brooch, designed as a cat playing with a cultured pearl, fitted with a safety chain, width 2.1cm.

Condition Report

564. Enamelled brooch ♦ there are a few surface nicks to the enamel work but no major unsightly chips. No attempts at past restoration, the hook to the back is replaced and is fitted to the back by a base metal panel, the hinge pin has been replaced and would benefit from reduction in length. Although unmarked it is likely to be silver.

Paste set cat brooch ♦ some discolouration to the paste and one or two chips, some pastes may have been replaced, the pearl has probably been replaced with evidence of glue.

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
