A pair of George V silver candlesticks, each cylindrical stem with anthemion decoration, on a square stepped base, Sheffield 1921 by Thomas Bradbury & Sons Ltd, height 13.5cm, together with a silver rectangular three-section stamp box with sprung sloping lid, on a gadrooned base, London 1896, length 8.5cm.

Condition Report

334. The candlesticks are ok, but just a bit worn with typical scratches, surface wear and small dents, particularly to nozzles and edges of bases. Hallmarks are clear, but a bit rubbed.

Stamp box is a bit worn with some small dents. Sprung hinge is good, but glass panel is missing and many of the securing flaps/pins have broken off. Marks are rubbed.
