A set of three George III silver graduated tea caddies and covers with strawberry finials, each of rectangular bombé form, chased with flowers and rococo scrolls, on scroll feet, London 1765 and 1766 by Pierre Gillois, heights 13cm and 13.5cm, total weight 783g, within original black fishskin covered casket with velvet lined interior, silver mounted handle and escutcheon, length 27cm.

Condition Report

350. All three caddies are in excellent condition. No significant damage or repairs, typical light wear and surface scratches, but chasing is good and crisp with very good detail to the highpoints. Lids fit tightly and securely. Each engraved crest is crisp.

The fishskin case is also in generally good condition, but with typical surface wear, scratches and nicks etc. It is missing its feet and one pin to secure the escutcheons, so this is a bit loose. One of the hinge pins is also missing. Velvet interior with typical wear. The key works and locks.
