A gold and diamond five stone ring, circa 1900, mounted with a row of cushion cut diamonds graduating in size to the centre stone, detailed '18ct', the mount decorated with scroll pierced sides, weight 2.8g, ring size approx Q, with a case.

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### Condition Report

722. The ring is in generally fairly good condition, if a little dirty and a bit worn. Typical light surface scratches and wear, and shank slightly misshapen. Diamonds are bright and sparkly, but they are dirty and have typical inclusions visible under magnification.

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
