### LOT 715

A gold and silver set, ruby and diamond brooch, circa 1900, with a trefoil shaped motif at the centre and a fleur-de-lis motif on either side, mounted with five cushion cut rubies, otherwise set with smaller cushion and rose cut diamonds, fitted with a safety chain, unmarked, weight 5.2g, width 5cm, with a case.

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### Condition Report

715. The brooch is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light wear commensurate with age. Diamonds are bright and sparkly. The rubies are an attractive pinky red colour and appear to be natural. Pin is ever so slightly misshapen.

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
