A gold, sapphire and seed pearl brooch, circa 1910, designed as a winged insect, mounted with the principal oval cut sapphire to the body, otherwise with seed pearl set wings and four sapphire set terminals, detailed '15ct', fitted with a safety chain, weight 7.4g, width 5.5cm, with a case.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

502. One leg has quite obviously been solder repaired. Principal sapphire has some minor wear to the table facet edge. Seed pearls have a pleasant lustre, one or two have minor cracks. Overall it is an attractive piece. The box has certainly been with the piece for some time, with the indentations evident. We would suggest it could well be the original box.

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
